- You have a fever (temperature above 100 degrees Fahrenheit).
- You are having any cold/flu symptoms.

While you are here, we ask that you:

- Encourage the use of a facial mask
- Sanitize any equipment, tools or tack that you touch.
- Practice a 6-foot social distancing perimeter between yourself and others.
- Do not touch your face.
- Wash your hands with soap and water regularly throughout the day.
