Enrollment

Camp is **not refundable**. We can offer your space as open. If and when it is filled, we are able to offer a refund or a credit.

There is a \$30 office fee charged for any changes made to your registration.

Cell Phone/Electronics Policy

Cell phones can be brought to camp, but they need to stay in backpacks. We discourage the use of cell phones because we want campers to be interacting and playing. Cell phones will be held by counselors if campers need reminders to leave their phones in their bags.

Dietary Needs

Please be advised that we may not be able to accommodate special dietary needs and requests. We do our best to ensure the safety of all our students.

Behavioral Expectations

Our program is not geared toward behavioral issues that require one on one supervision. We require for the safety and success of our program that campers are able to be successful in a group environment. Bullying and disruptive behavior is not permitted and is grounds for dismissal.

Lice Policy

All campers will undergo a brief lice check. Please note that if lice or lice eggs are found, you must bring your child home to undergo lice treatment. This is a minimum of 24-hour process. We require a note from a doctor that they are clear of lice. After all lice have been removed from the child, they may return to camp. No refunds are given for missed camp due to lice.

Having lice is not a reflection on your family's cleanliness or nurturing. Lice is incredibly contagious. We treat children with lice with respect and compassion.

Sick Policy

For the safety and success of all campers and staff, we rely on parents to keep sick campers' home. Please do not bring campers to camp if they have a fever above 100 degrees or vomiting within last 24 hours, or any other cold/flu symptoms. Please reach out to us if you are unsure if your camper is well enough to attend.

Campers showing signs of illness at camp will be sent home. No refunds are given for missed camp due to illness.
